



Mediation Accreditation Courses

Title	Duration	Description
Accreditation Program as a Public Sector ADR Provider	10 Days	The Office for Alternative Dispute Resolution requires 80 hours of training in order to receive accreditation. This program covers all topics required with additional modules on developing a mediator mindset to fully develop the practitioner.
Accreditation Program as a Private Sector Mediator for Business	10 Days	The course is designed for those who wish to be accredited with the National Center for Mediation, a private sector institution that provides commercial mediation services to the business sector.
Cooperative Sector Mediator Program	10 Days	Mediation at the cooperative level has proven to be effective in resolving cases, particularly those that affect the liquidity of the organization, as well as its leadership. Take the first step towards being accredited by your own coop by completing this 80-hour course.
Deepening of Values Awareness Course: An Advanced Program for Mediators*	5 Days	Designed for those who have completed the 80-hour mediation course, this is an extension of the practical internship course where mediators shall handle actual dispute cases. Mentors shall provide guidance for further enhancement of skills and deepening of the mindset of a third party neutral.
Advanced Skills in Dialogue Facilitation	3 Days	Designed for those who completed the basic mediation program, this is a workshop introducing additional skills in handling issues between a larger group of stakeholders.
